7. William ROOTS died 1 January 1858 aged 63 years. AbraAnn his wife died 12 January 1858 aged 60 years. Left issue Sarah Ann, James, William, Stephen and Esther. Also James Roots brother of the above died 27 March 1837 in his 49<sup>th</sup> year.
8. Sophia wife of William ERRY died 17 February 1866 aged 68 years. Also William Erry died 27 January 1869 aged 74 years.

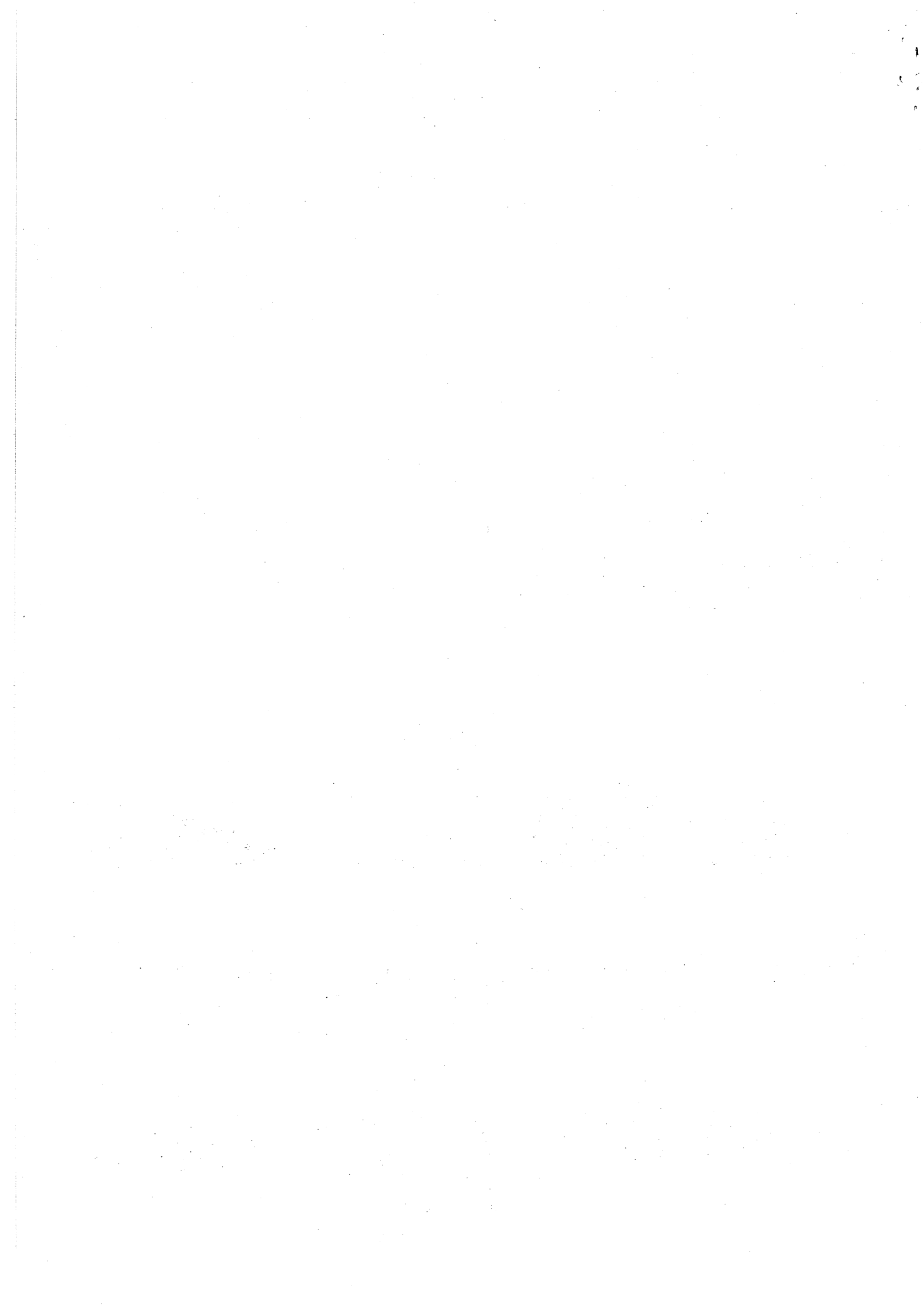
